RULES ABOUT THE EXHIBITION OF BIRDS INCLUDED IN C.I.T.E.S.

Before caging operations, exhibitors must give to authorities 1 copy of the document stating the birth in captivity of the bird. Copy must be signed by the Wildlife Guards as by D.L. n° 2 del 12/01/93.

Hybrids who have at least a relative included in C.I.T.E.S. must have the above document, too.

LOCAL RULES ABOUT EXHIBITION OF AUTOCHTHONOUS WILDLIFE BIRDS

During the caging operations, exhibitors must show copy of document issued by the local authorities stating a legitimacy of detention and reproduction of the birds.

Both exhibition and market, all exhibitors must show International Health Certificate filled in every field during all caging operations or else must stay out exhibition's pavillons

RINGS CHECKING

All the birds in exhibition must have a FOI/COM irremovable ring. In case of ring absence or with an irregular one, exhibitors will be disqualified and every penalties will be communicated to the authorities.

OPENING CEREMONY

THE OPENING CEREMONY WILL TAKE PLACE SATURDAY NOVEMBER 21ND AT 11 AM AND THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES WILL BE ATTENDING. DURING THE CEREMONY THE EXHIBITION WILL BE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

Bookings

Bookings will be accepted by carrier, registered letter or by fax (number +39/522/515118), between 10 and 15 october. In order to allow more exhibitors to get in, only in Colour Bred Canaries and Gloster Categories, SOR decided to accept up maximum 30 birds per exhibitors.

Caging operations

Caging operations will start on Sunday November 15th from 8AM to 19 PM and Monday 16th from 8 AM to 2,30 PM.

To make caging operations faster, conveyors can get in touch with Mr. Pietro Curti (mobile +39/3333577434) to let him know day and time of arrival in order to make all the caging operations easier.

Only on Sunday November 16th exchanges can be made, up to 3 birds.

Nochanging will be allowed on Monday November 16th.

Market exhibition

Every SOR's cage can contain maximum six (6) small sized birds. Exhibitors can use their own cages and/or booking the numbered tables (minimum booking: 1 table. 1 table can not be shared between more than one exhibitor). Exhibitors using their own cages must remember that the wellness of the animals must be guaranteed; supplies of food and fresh water must be taken care of as well, complying with the rules.

Assisted uncaging

Uncaging operations will start on November 22rd at 5,30 PM. Exhibitors must withdraw the uncaging form on Sunday november 22rd. The forms come in different colours, depending on the different areas birds belong to. Exhibitors must then reach the areas bearing the same colours as their uncaging forms to be then taken to the exhibitions' room where the uncaging operation will be done. The exhibitors willing to exchange birds with other exhibitors must wait until the uncaging operations are over and, most of all, exchange birds outside the exhibition's pavillons.
